Objectives These workshops are held to encourage discussion among researchers in the New England area who are studying soft condensed matter and to introduce students and postdocs to the local research community.

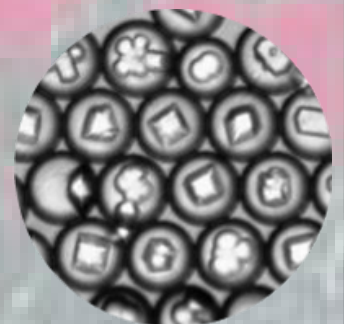
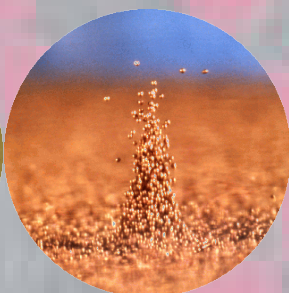
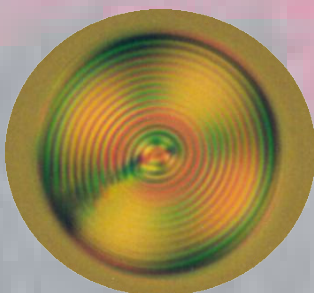
Sound bites Two sessions of **5 minute** sound bites are planned so that participants can highlight results from current research projects.

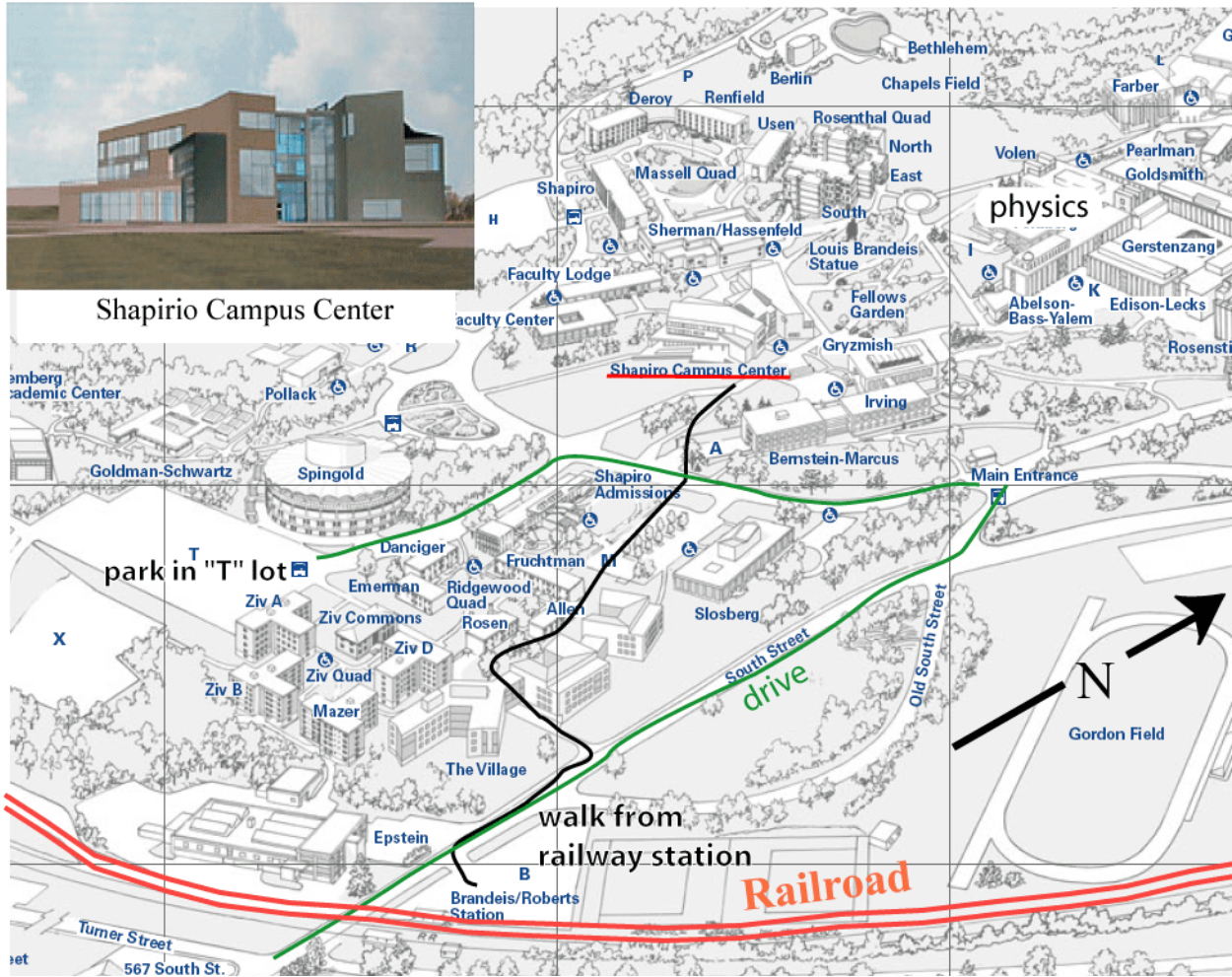

If you are walking from the train, first cross South St, head north and enter campus (on your left). Navigate through dormitories and proceed to the **Shapiro Campus Center** (and not Shapiro Science Center or Shapiro Athletic Facility!).
